Adobe Releases Out-of-Band Security Patches on there Products

Dear Constituents,

Adobe have finally released pre-announced out-of-band security updates to patch a total of 82 security vulnerabilities across its various products.

Affected Software include the following:

- Adobe Acrobat and Reader
- Adobe Experience Manager
- Adobe Experience Manager Forms
- Adobe Download Manager

Out of 82 security vulnerabilities, 45 are rated critical, and all of them affects Adobe Acrobat and Reader, if it's exploited successfully, then could lead to arbitrary code execution in the context of the current user.

Adobe Acrobat and Reader for Microsoft Windows and Apple macOS operating systems has also received patches for 23 important-rated vulnerabilities that could lead to information disclosure attacks due to out-of-bounds read and cross-site scripting issues.

What to do

Users of the affected Adobe software are highly recommended to update their software packages to the latest versions as soon as possible.

Please note that information may subject to change and for the users to keep track of specific advisories.
