Security Updates for Microsoft and other vendors for March 2023

Dear Constituents,

Microsoft's has released their March Patch Tuesday security updates. They have released fixes with a total of 83 Vulnerabilities. Out of these vulnerabilities, 9 are classified as Critical, as they allow remote code execution, spoofing, Denial of Service and privilege elevation.
